

College Preparation for Sophomores

- Look at your SCOIR account and see the careers that are the “strongest matches” with your interests and abilities.
- Mark the ones “saved” in SCOIR that you think you will pursue.
- Look at what education or training is needed for these careers.
- Look at colleges that can provide you the education/training needed for one or more of these careers.
- Find out what their admission requirements are (i.e. Do you need to take Chemistry? What college entrance test do you need to take?)
- Use SCOIR to check out colleges/universities and take a virtual tour.
- Start visiting colleges during the summer between sophomore and junior year if not before. You can also set up a virtual visit through college websites or via SCOIR.
- Use the handy sheet called “Campus Visit Questions” found under the topic, College Search Engines to give you an idea of what to look for and/or ask when you do a college visit.
- Contact Mrs. Green for anything else you might need for your college preparation.
