*takes place during another class, usually one day per week.

** no class time, includes assignments/expectations from throughout the year.

- Homework <u>will</u> be assigned.
 - Strategies for Success study hall class is designed to help with homework load.
 - Expect 30 40 minutes of homework a night.
 - This should be doable if you use your time wisely.
- Wednesday late-start (5 minutes later for teacher meetings)
- Personal Skills
 - Develop 6 personal skills important to professional success, future schooling and internships.
 - Follows the MTCHS Professional Framework
 - Expanded upon in future classes (Employment Prep, Senior Seminar)
- Activity Days
 - School-wide (all grades participate)
 - Usually takes up the entire school day.
 - Students are graded on attitude and participation.
 - Students will make up activity time if they are absent.
 - Students sign up for preferred activities from a list.
 - All students will be assigned to their first or second choice of activity.
- Wednesday Fitness
 - Replaces Spanish one day per week.
 - Students participate in some type of physical activity/game.
 - Promotes school community and culture, getting to know peers while exercising.
 - Students are graded on attitude and participation.
 - Students will make up fitness time if they are absent.

- Community Service & Professional Dress
 - Community Service:
 - Every year, **9 hours** of community service must be completed.
 - Must submit form (on Moodle) documenting hours to Mr. Pence.
 - There will be school-based opportunities to earn hours.
 - Professional Dress:
 - 9 professional dress days each year, every year.
 - Prepares students for the world of work, job environment.
 - Must be completed or made up in a timely manner.
