##### Adobe Premiere Pro

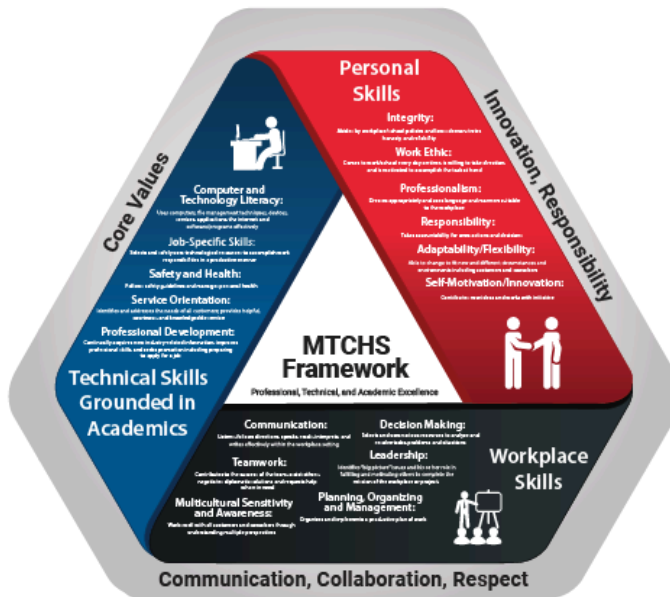
#### VIDEO PRODUCTION
