

Skills USA – Web Design Competition

MTCHS Tech Fair – 2024

Purpose – Develop an online website utilizing the content given and provided by the competition. This will include text files and images files. The focus of this contest is on client side technologies (for example, HTML, CSS, and JavaScript). No server side scripting is to be included in the submitted materials. No pre-built templates will be allowed. All materials submitted are to be free of malware (submitting a virus or spyware is grounds for immediate disqualification).

Judging - The judges will be representing a client that has engaged your services to create a website. Teams will be required to initially plan a website then implement pages, including a home page and interior pages based on the text content provided. Throughout the contest, proctors will be available to answer basic questions as the client. All included information, images, text and content should be represented on final website.

Deliverables – The following is a list of items **required** during the competition. Each team is responsible for notifying a proctor when a task incomplete and delivered via the competition Moodle Course.

1. **JOB1 - Color Logo** - PDF Upload -**Job 1**
2. **JOB2 - Generic Wireframe web layout** – PDF upload -**Job 2**
3. **JOB3- Completed website uploaded to folder-smtchs** (ADVANCED teams) – or Uploaded wix **URL** (BASIC teams) -**Job 3**

JOB STEPS BELOW: There are 3 Jobs to complete plus **one 10 point Bonus Job-**

Job 1: Design a **Company logo** that includes company name and used on the website-
Upload as PDF: 25 points

This is a created from scratch color logo that includes the name.

“PipeCo Inc.”

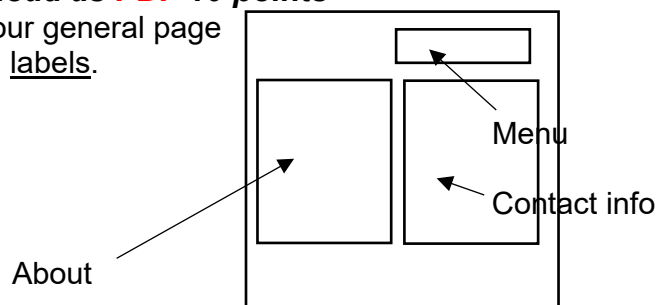
>Upload Job 1 as a pdf to moodle. Save as Yournames.pdf

Job 2: Mockup Wireframe Layout: Upload as PDF 10 points

Job 3: Site Design, Functionality and Completeness: Upload 45 points.

Create as much of the new site as you can in the time allotted. Complete sites will include working navigational links, as well as appropriate images and actual web content information from the .txt files made available to you in the Competition Zip File.

BEGINNER WEB:

Upload a **PUBLISHED http: link** to your website for the judges to see your website and score.

ADVANCED WEB: Special Items -

***Note #1:** Be sure Logo and Slogan is used and visible on website -

***Note #2:** Be sure your site has a consistent **Footer** on all pages suitable for your prompt

***Note #3:** Create and utilize a **Favicon** on your website related to your logo

Upload a working **http: link** to your website for the judges to use to see your website and score.

* **Bonus Points:** *Contact Form 10 points.* (**Basic and Advanced** Groups)

Create a Contact Form for people to request information from the company website

Your form should be on the Contact page or Contact part of the website.

- Form should use verification for full points
- Form should be stylized

Bonus: This Step will be graded as part of the websites functionality-
