Course Overview

After 1st Quarter, Freshmen who are passing their FLT class and have a 3.0 GPA or higher are eligible to enroll in Advanced Technical Training. This class takes place during their current FLT class. The students will be given the opportunity to study a technical subject of their choice from MTCHS's technical areas during their FLT class time. Students will have access to the technical pathway teachers for help if needed, and an opportunity to use their time to attain an extra high school credit, and possibly, a certification.

 - Cyber Security
 - Build a Computer (Virtually)
- Programming Focus Area
 - Python
- Media Design Focus Area
 - Illustrator
- Electronics Focus Area
 - SolidWorks CAD

<u>Grading</u>

Students will receive a pass/fail grade in ATT dependent on progress through lessons.

Reward for Completion

- Students who complete a course in an advanced learning area, up to and including the certification for that area, will be rewarded with one high school elective credit when they complete the <u>equivalent of</u> <u>60 hours of coursework.</u>
- Other benefits of completion include:
 - Resume Builder
 - More Skills, More Likely to Get a Better Job/Internship
 - Opportunities to Explore Different Technical Areas at MTCHS
 - Certification

<u>Commitments</u>

- Students may work on MTCHS school work at any time. Other classwork is priority.
- Students commit to keeping their GPA at a 3.0 or above. If their GPA falls below 3.0 for three or more weeks they may lose their opportunity to have access to their Advanced Coursework.
- Students who finish a course of study early will be able to study an additional course of study for the remainder of the year.
