Course

MTCHS students earn a Citizenship and Professional grade each of their four years. Students engage in community service and activity days, practice professional dress, and target MTCHS Framework goals. Grade level meetings and small group meetings occur throughout the year.

Standards

This course targets the <u>Idaho Workplace Skills for Career Readiness Standards</u> through the <u>MTCHS Framework</u>. The MTCHS Framework includes seventeen skills in three categories: Personal Skills, Workplace Skills, and Technical Skills.

MTCHS students are introduced to the Framework Skills beginning freshman year and build fluency. They generalize across school environments as sophomores and adapt the skills outside of school as juniors and seniors. The MTCHS Framework Skills targeted in this class include:
